The Petrarchan sonnet rhyme scheme is similar in some aspects, but it uses repetition differently. These poems follow a rhyme scheme of ABBAABBACDCDCD. While the first eight lines (ABBAABBA) are always the same, the last six can change. Other popular endings to these poems include patterns like CDECDE and CDEEDC.

### **The 5 Different Rhyme Scheme of Sonnets Explained | Poem ...**

A "rhyme scheme" is a way of describing the pattern of end rhymes in a poem. Each new sound at the end of a line is given a letter, starting with "A," then "B," and so on. If an end sound repeats the end sound of an earlier line, it gets the same letter as the earlier line.

A rhyme scheme is the pattern of rhymes at the end of each line of a poem or song. It is usually referred to by using letters to indicate which lines rhyme; lines designated with the same letter all rhyme with each other. Rhyme scheme (RHY SKEEm) is the ordered occurrence of rhymes at the end of the lines of a poem or verse. While rhyme can also occur within lines of poetry, the term rhyme scheme indicates the pattern of rhyme at the end of the lines. In other words, a rhyme scheme is the blueprint for a poem's rhyming pattern.

### **Rhyme Scheme in Literature: Definition & Examples ...**

Many writers use a form of poetry that follows the same rhyme scheme. For example, the Elizabethan, or Shakespearean, sonnet rhyme scheme is ABAB, CDCD, EFEF, GG. You can find many other forms of poetry that use different rhyme schemes.

### **How to Analyze the Rhyme Scheme of a Poem | Pen and the Pad**

Rhyme. The repetition of syllables, typically at the end of a verse line. Rhymed words conventionally share all sounds following the word's last stressed syllable. Thus "tenacity" and "mendacity" rhyme, but not "jaundice" and "John does," or "tomboy" and "calm bay.". A rhyme scheme is usually the pattern of end rhymes in a stanza, with each rhyme encoded by a letter of the alphabet, from a onward (ABBA BCCB, for example).
